

Evaluation of Credit from a Foreign Country

University/college coursework completed outside the United States must be submitted to an organization that specializes in evaluating foreign transcripts. John A. Logan College recommends use of Educational Credential Evaluators (www.ece.org) or Educational Perspectives (www.edperspective.org) for an official evaluation of earned foreign credentials.

- You are responsible for all fees associated with credential evaluation.
- **“Catalog Match”** or **“Course-by-Course”** evaluation reports will be accepted for credit transfer purposes.
- Course descriptions must accompany the **“Course-by-Course”** report.
- All documents that you submit, or are submitted on your behalf, become the property of the College, and will not be released to you or any other party.

The Admissions office at John A. Logan College will use the results of the evaluation report, along with course descriptions, to determine transfer of foreign credit to the College.
